

Heritage and Archaeology


There are no designated heritage assets located inside the boundary of the application site.

12 Scheduled Monuments were identified within a 5km study zone, while 18 Listed Buildings (including one Category A, six Category B and 11 Category C) were identified within the 2km study zone. In addition, a total of 28 non-designated assets identified within the Historic Environment Record (HER) are located within a 1km study area.

Non-designated remains of the Tealing Military Airfield are situated inside and adjacent to the boundary of the application site. As the military airfield occupied part of the application site, sub-surface remains are likely to be associated with this period while the potential for earlier remains is **low**.

A Cultural Heritage Impact Assessment (CHIA) has been undertaken and will be included with the planning application. The CHIA involved a desk-based assessment as well as the completion of a site walkover survey and geophysical survey.

The heritage assets (including non-designated) identified near the site have been assessed for potential indirect effects within the CHIA, but such effects are anticipated to be **Minor Adverse or Negligible**.



A walkover and geophysical survey identified features presumed to be associated with the airfield and agricultural usage of the land (see above figure for geophysical survey results).

Direct impacts upon the surviving fabric of the airfield will be mitigated through a programme of archaeological work to be agreed with the Energy Consents Unit and Angus Council's Historic Environment Team.
